Senior Skipper

ROLE DESCRIPTION

As a Senior Skipper, you will play a crucial role in ensuring the successful delivery and operation of your assigned flotilla. As a supporting team leader, you will be assigned to lead and oversee performance of a team of up to 10 professional skippers and crew.

In this exciting role you will be responsible for and undertake the following:

- Ensuring the safety of guests and your yacht throughout the week and when assigned, the safety of guests, staff and the yacht fleet as a whole
- Maintain the general upkeep and cleanliness of your yacht
- Preparation of breakfast and lunch onboard your yacht in line with company standards
- Interact and socialise with guests, teaching guests basic sailing skills if they so wish
- Coordinate the weekly itinerary with the Lead Skipper
- When required, act as Lead Skipper and report to the Route Manager
- Monitor all skippers and crew in your assigned flotilla, ensuring minimum standards are upheld and codes of conduct are adhered to
- Report to the Lead Skipper with regards to yacht maintenance, route planning, guest experience and staff performance
- Support other skippers during yacht check-in/out for your flotilla; including maintenance, provisioning, cleaning and all required procedural documentation
- Document all incidents and damages in line with the company reporting procedures
- Represent MedSailors in a positive manner to all port authorities and operational partners at all times
- Any other duties as directed by the Route Manager
